- **BENEFITS**

You probably have great people working in your community, but sometimes an outside perspective can be helpful. And no one knows the industry like ULI. We're the pre-eminent cross-disciplinary organization, dedicated to best practices — learning, connecting, and giving back.

Seven Steps to a TAP

1. Apply to ULI Indiana as described at left.
2. A ULI representative will meet with you to help refine your project scope and develop a better understanding of the problem.
3. ULI will identify and recruit our members who are experts in the fields that can help you, like real estate developers attorneys, architects and more.
4. ULI will work with you to develop the project schedule and contract and identify what we'll need from you (data, maps, etc.).
5. Panel time! The panelists will come to your community for one to two days, depending on your project scope. You will be on hand to help them understand the problem and introduce them to local stakeholders.
6. The panelists will work on the problem and the TAP will conclude with a presentation of their findings.
7. ULI will help you by summarizing the conclusions and next steps.
